Schedule of Services to support Falmouth BID renewal 2019

The Falmouth Town Council provides a number of services within the Falmouth Business Improvement District Area and these include:

- Support for activities that take place in the Town at Christmas including:
 1. Christmas Lights
 2. Event Support – Live Nativity, Festive Shopping etc.
- Event Management – this includes provision of PLI for jointly delivered events, management of road closures and all other associated direct and indirect costs relating to the comprehensive schedule of events within Falmouth’s Annual Calendar - including support for civic events such as Armistice Day and other local annual commemoration events.
- Town Management Service including the management of public realm CCTV
- Provision of Cultural Services including; the running of the devolved Library Service; the free to access Falmouth Art Gallery; educational workshops for local education providers – from Baby-Paint to Internships
- Administration support for all corporate and cultural services
- Hanging Baskets and contributions towards Town Dressing
- Additional street cleansing – over and above the County commissioned services
- Moor Piazza Management including the management of the twice-weekly traders market and use of the space as a destination during events
- Funding for the Falmouth’s Shuttle Bus Services
- Delivery of weed clearance across the town
- Provision of free public conveniences and enhanced opening to support events
- Management & maintenance of Dracaena Ave Sports & Recreation area
- Management & maintenance of Falmouth’s five roundabouts
- Local burial services and the maintenance of Falmouth’s cemeteries
- Registration and active site support for the Scheduled Jewish and Dissenters Cemeteries at Ponsharden
- Provision of premise to support community meetings etc
- Management & maintenance of Falmouth’s parks – Kimberley, Trescobeas and The Bowly
- Environmental education & enforcement

- Additional support for enhanced beach management and seaweed clearance
- Provision, management & maintenance of children's play facilities
- Provision of Youth Co-ordinator role provided at The Dracaena Centre
- Provision of Allotments and the support & liaison with Falmouth Allotments association
- Support & liaison with Falmouth's various community groups
- Management & maintenance of various small borders in the town, including Webber Hill and the Memorial Border in Webber St
- Community planning consultee
- Assessment of tree work planning applications
- Admin and organization for "In Bloom" activities.
- Support for the privately-run Visitor Information Centre

Falmouth Town Council is a proactive Council who participates fully in partnership working.

Delivery of future services is subject to budget approval annually and likely to change with consultations already underway regarding the devolution of various services.
