



environmental advances. Suzanne Savill finds out more The historic wooden ferry Kingsley II can usually be seen on the River Fall in Cornwall. However, when world leaders meet in Glasgow for the 26th UN Climate Change Conference of the Parties (COP26) it will be among a flotilla of environmentally friendly vessels on the River Clyde. The Falmouth-based vessel, owned by

River Fal Cornwall (Cornwall Ferries Ltd) has changed little in external appearance since it was built in 1934.

However, it is powered by a cutting-edge hybrid electrical engine that is the result of the Hybrid Electrical Vessel propulsion with Integrated Motor Assist project, which involved engineers from REAP Systems.
